JOB SUMMARY:

The library is located in the Geophysical Institute/International Arctic Research Center in Fairbanks, Alaska. It is the most northern special library in the United States that focuses on polar physical sciences. This international collection includes approximately 24,000 journal volumes and 76,000 books and reports, of which over 600 are specialized historical books. Special collections include; International Northern Sea Route, International Historical Glaciological Volumes, International Geophysical Year (IGY), Chemistry of the Earth's Interior (IAVCEI) and Alaska Department of Transportation Library. The library routinely provides support for approximately 600 local research scientist, staff and students. Scientists, both national and international, are frequent visitors to this unique collection.
